Venue

Kragujevac is a historical, economical, administrative, cultural, science, educational, health and industrial center of the Šumadija region in Serbia. It is located in central Šumadija and Serbia, 140km south of the capital city of Belgrade. The city spans along the banks of the river Lepenica in the Kragujevac valley, surrounded by Rudnik, Crni vrh and Gledić mountains, at 200m above sea-level. The city is home to around 190 000 residents.

The city is fist mentioned in the middle ages, and the first written sign of it comes from 1476 where in Ottoman documents it is called Karagovindja, a town "on the Belgrade road 19 days away from Constantinople". It got its name from the kraguj sparrowhawk which was hunted in the middle ages, today extinct, it finds its honorary place on the city's coat of arms.

Culturally- historical heritage of Kragujevac was greatly determined by the fact that in the period between 1818-1841 it was the capital, cultural, educational and political center of modern Serbia. Numerous events shaped the cultural, political and social development of Kragujevac firmly establishing its importance in the national identity of Serbia.

Today, Kragujevac is a mecca for investors, the city with a favorable business climate and accelerated local economic development.

The Faculty of Mechanical Engineering in Kragujevac was formed on the initiative former Kraqujevac County in 1960. The faculty changed its name from Faculty of Mechanical Engineering to Faculty of Engineering in 2011. The "Svetozar Marković" University, today University of Kragujevac was founded in 1976. The University today consists of 12 faculties.
